APAC – Equities Sales and Trading Summer Analyst

Description

The Equities Summer Analyst program is 10 weeks in length and is designed to give the participants a comparable experience to that of a First Year Analyst. As part of the program, Summer Analysts may find themselves spending time in one or more functions (sales, salestrading, trading or structuring) within one of our main product groups (Cash, CB and Derivatives, Prime Services). There will be daily morning sales and trading calls as well as weekly meetings, all of which will provide them greater insights into the markets and business. In addition, to complement the understanding of the Equities business Summer Analysts gain from their day-to-day tasks and assignments, there will be a series of presentations by our Equities senior managers which will help them develop a holistic picture of our Equities business.

Each Summer Analyst will be given an Internship Project to work on throughout the summer on top of his/her daily tasks and is required to do a final presentation at the end of the program. Summer Analysts are formally reviewed at the mid and end points of the summer.

Our opportunities are primarily in Hong Kong.

Training

Strong verbal and written knowledge of an Asian language, preferably Mandarin, though not a pre-requisite, would be considered favorably in your application.
