# 2. Using Tellus for Interview Practice:

## 2.1. When can I start my interview? Is there a deadline?

You can start your interview at any time by clicking on the provided interview link. We recommend being prepared and finding a quiet place to conduct the interview. The interview will expire on June 1, 2025. So make sure to complete your interview before that date. This deadline is in place to ensure the interview questions remain current and relevant.

## 2.2. Do I need a camera and microphone for this interview?

Yes, you will need both a web camera and microphone to participate in the interview.

### 2.3. What device should I use to conduct the interview?

Please use your laptop or desktop to conduct the interview. Tellus does not support smartphones or tablets at the moment. However, we are constantly exploring ways to enhance accessibility and may consider supporting these devices in future updates.

### 2.4. How long is my interview going to be?

The estimated time of the interview is around 16 minutes with 5 questions.

### 2.5. Can I preview the questions before the interview?

We aim to simulate a real-world interview experience, which involves responding to questions in the moment. Therefore, we do not provide a preview of the questions beforehand. This approach helps assess your ability to think on your feet and demonstrate your knowledge and skills effectively during the interview.

### 2.6. Can I retake my interview?

## 2.8. When will I be able to view the AI interview results?

The availability of AI interview results varies depending on the number of interviews being processed concurrently. Typically, it takes about 10-20 minutes to process one interview. However, during peak periods with a high volume of submissions, processing times may be longer. Interview results will typically be available within 1 to 2 days.
